Lawyer and rights advocate Teela Reid to speak at Catholic Education's Kaartdijin Week

Accomplished lawyer, educator and Wiradjuri and Wailwan woman Teela Reid will be sharing her insights on treaty and the Uluru Statement from the Heart at Catholic Education Western Australia's (CEWA) upcoming Kaartdijin Week.

The 33-year-old solicitor has been recognised for her advocacy and leadership by Harvard University, has been a youth delegate to the United Nations Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues, was the first Aboriginal person elected Vice-President (Social Justice) of the UNSW Law Society, and will be travelling to Perth to speak with Catholic education leaders, educators and guests in September.

Ms Reid's keynote will be one of the highlights of CEWA's Kaartdijin Week (kaartdijin means knowledge in Noongar), a week of events at the Catholic Education Centre in Leederville that will support Indigenous Literacy Day, promote Aboriginal education in Catholic schools, and revisit the NAIDOC theme of Voice. Treaty. Truth.

The keynote with Ms Reid is a free event with a limited number of spaces, but is open to educators from other sectors and the public.
